We also have resident kingfishers.

Please take care when walking around the site, some of the grassed areas are uneven due to rabbits and the general terrain.

Water and some use of electricity per day are included in your pitch fees, however, please help us minimise our effect on the environment by considering your usage while on site. Please do not charge electric cars from your electric supply. There are charging facilities a few miles from here. Thank you.
